Egling Families,

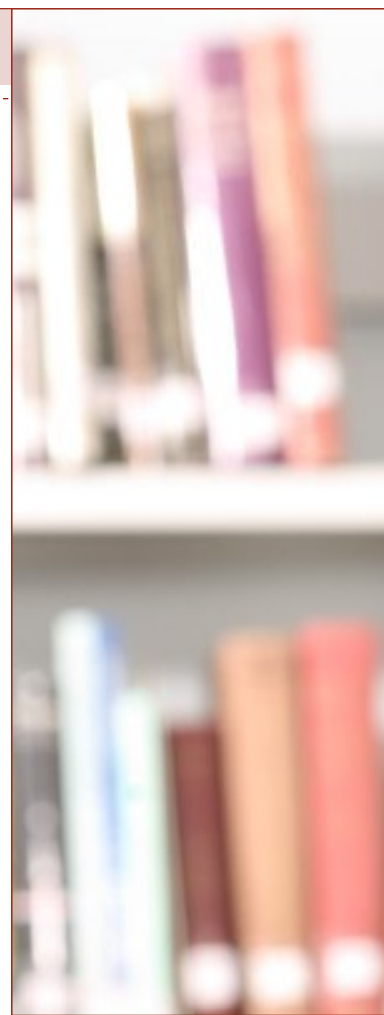
